

LIBRARY

Fully air conditioned college library is situated at the 1st floor of administrative building. The library is a spacious hall, well furnished with comfortable seating arrangement and silent atmosphere. It provides seating arrangement of 300 students at a time & remains open from 8 AM to 8 PM of all working days. There is a separate reading room for the faculty members with internet facilities. It is run by the chief librarian with two assistant librarians & other staffs under the guidance of Library Committee.

The library is fairly enriched with collection of common text books, reference books, important national and international journals. Recently about 5000 current medical text books on different disciplines are collected.



CAFETERIA

The Medical College has a well-decorated Cafeteria in College Campus. About 100 persons can take food at a time in the cafeteria. It is excellent for serving food such as breakfast, lunch, dinner and various delicious snacks.





HOSTEL FACILITIES

Separate Boys' and Girls' Hostels are situated on the east flank of the campus adjacent to the college playground and enriched with dining hall, reading room and common room with indoor games facilities. An experienced supervisor is engaged to solve their day to day problems and priorities.

COLLEGE ADMINISTRATION

Principal is the executive head of the college (AMC) and honourable Chairman is the executive head of the Governing Body. Other members of the Governing Body are according to the rules of Dhaka University. The college runs on non-profit basis.

Principal along with the academic council looks after human resource management, educational programs and maintains academic environment in the college. Head of all Departments, Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, Registrars, Assistant Registrars, Medical Officers & Concerned staffs help the Principal to implement academic programs and to maintain academic atmosphere of the college.



ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The College Academic Council is formed with the Principal, Vice Principal and senior faculty members ranging from Professors to Assistant Professors of all the Departments. Academic Council is the highest decision making authority of the college regarding all academic activities, administrative and student matters specially student welfare related issues.

The decisions of the Academic Council are within the legal framework of the country and not in conflict with the rules of the Directorate of Health Services, BMDC & Dhaka University.



ADMISSION INTO MBBS COURSE

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of students for admission into MBBS course depends on the basis of National Merit List which is based on results of SSC, HSC and admission test. Candidate will have to 40 marks in admission test. Separate merit lists of illegible candidates are published by the Director, Medical Education of DGHS both for Government and Private Medical Colleges. Selected candidates shall have to get admission by the announced date. Otherwise their selection may be cancelled and the vacant will be filled up by the candidates of waiting list.

EXPENSE OF STUDY

Total expense for admission will be decided by the Govt. of Bangladesh. Tuition fees and all other fees payable at the time of admission will be notified by the college authority.

BOND/UNDERTAKING

The candidates and their parents or guardians are required to sign bonds on non-judicial stamp regarding the terms and conditions of study, conduct and discipline during admission into the college.

STIPENDS/SCHOLARSHIPS

Free studentship is available for 5% meritorious and financially insolvent students. Separate applications are to be submitted for this category. A separate committee formed by the Govt. will finally select the appropriate candidates.

Criteria for admission of Foreign Students in The Nongovernment Medical Colleges in Bangladesh for 2019-2020 Academic Year Under Self- finance Scheme.

1. Equivalence of Foreign Degree

- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent).
- SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2017.
- · HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2019.
- · Minimum aggregated GPA in SSC or equivalent and HSC or equivalent: 8.00 (eight).
- Minimum GPA either in SSC or equivalent and or in HSC or equivalent: 3.0
- Minimum GPA in Biology: 3.5
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC or equivalent exam., only top 5 subjects are considered.
- Therefore, GPA in SSC or equivalent examination = Total marks obtained in top five subjects.
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC or equivalent exam., only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered.
- Therefore, GPA in HSC or equivalent examination = Total marks obtained in three subjects.



- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC or equivalent exam., only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered.
- Therefore, GPA in HSC or equivalent examination = Total marks obtained in three subjects.

2. Application Form

Three (3) copies of duly filled application forms along with the following documents should be sent to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Dhaka:

- · Copy of passport.
- · Six (6) Passport size photographs.
- All certificates duly attested by the competent authority, i. e. the Education Ministry of the respective country and also be authenticated by the respective Bangladesh Missions abroad/ Foreign Missions based in Dhaka.

3. Application Fee

Each application must attach with a non refundable Demand Draft or Telegraphic Transfer (TT) of US\$ 60.00 (sixty) payable to: "The Director, Medical Education and HMPD, DGHS, Mohakhali, Dhaka, Bangladesh".

- 4. Only the applications processed through Bangladesh Missions abroad or through the Missions in Dhaka of respective countries will be considered for admission. Applications must reach the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Dhaka within the deadline, which will be published in the websites of DGHS, Bangladesh (www.dghs.gov.bd) and Consulate of Bangladesh (www.bangladeshconsulatela.com).
- 5. Applications should be submitted in the prescribed form to be available from DGHS Website:www. dghs.gov.bd). Attested copies of certificates and mark-sheets etc. have to be submitted along with the applications. All certificates and marks-sheets must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. No application will be accepted without attestation.
- 6. To ensure citizenship of foreign students, attested copies of passport must be submitted along with the applications. The certificates/ mark sheets and other testimonials need to be attested by the respective country's education board/ education ministry.
- Candidates interested in seeking admission in AMC, need to mention the name of Ashiyan Medical College in their applications.
- Successful applicants will have to produce all the original academic certificates and mark-sheets/ transcripts during their admission.



DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CANDIDATE

All enclosures must be attested by Class-I Government Gazetted Officer.

- a) Photocopy of SSC & HSC/ Equivalent examination Mark sheets/ Academic Transcripts.
- b) Four copies of recent passport size colored photographs.
- c) Nationality certificate from appropriate Authority.
- d) A result sheet of admission test.
- e) Photocopy of Admit card (Admission Test).

At the time of admission the original documents are to be submitted and will be retained by the college.

ACADEMIC COURSE CURRICULUM

The college offers five years MBBS course and one year internship training in Ashiyan Medical College & Hospital as required by Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council leading to MBBS degree of the University of Dhaka. The academic session shall be from January each year or as suggested by Government.

The MBBS course is divided into four phases.

NB: Pass mark is 60%. Student shall have to pass written (MCQ + SAQ + formative), oral, practical and clinical examination separately & 85% of the total marks in each subject is considered the Honors' mark.



IN-COURSE EXAMINATIONS

Students are expected to maintain a consistently high standard in the academic performance. The in-course evaluations will be made through regular periodic class tests, assignments, card final and term final examinations conducted by individual departments. The term final examination shall include written (combinations of MCQs & short questions), orals, practicals/clinical including OSPE and OSCEs. The result shall be recorded in student's progress report cards/ log book and 10% of marks of each subject in the University professional examinations shall come from scores obtained in In-course formative evalutions. No student shall be allowed to sit for Professional MBBS examination of the University unless he/ she attends a minimum 75% of total classes, secure at least 60% marks in term final examinations and demonstrates satisfactory attitude, behavior and conduct.

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING IN PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS

1ST PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

- Completed one and a half year course.
- ❖ At least 75% class attendance in lecture, practical & demonstration classes separately.
- Successful completion of cards in all subjects.
- Successful completion of 3 term examinations.
- Certificate of good conduct from the concerned departments.

2ND PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

- Passed in 1st Professional MBBS Exam.
- Completed 1 year course.
- ♦ At least 75% class attendance in lecture, practical & demonstration classes separately.
- Successful completion of 3 term examinations.
- Certificate of good conduct from the concerned departments.

3RD PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

- Passed in 2nd Professional MBBS Exam.
- Completed 1 year course.
- At least 75% class attendance in lecture, practical & demonstration classes separately.
- Successful completion of RFST.
- Successful completion of 3 term examinations.
- Certificate of good conduct from the concerned departments.



FINAL PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

- Passed in the 3rd Professional MBBS Exam.
- Completed three & a half year of academic course after passing 1st professional MBBS Exam.
- At least 75% class attendance in lecture, practical & demonstration classes separately.
- Successful completion of cards & clinical exam. in all subjects.
- Successful completion of Block Posting.
- Paid college dues (if any).
- Certificate of good conduct from the concerned departments.

INTERNSHIP TRAINING

After passing final professional MBBS examination students have to enroll for one year log book based rotatory internship program. Within this one year 11 months and 15 days at medical college hospital and 15 days at UHC. Internship program will be more structured and supervised. It is compulsory to complete Internship Training Program designed by BM&DC to get permanent registration for doing independent practice.

The training is mainly designed to develop necessary skills and attitudes to deal with common health problems generally encountered in hospital and in community. This is structured and strictly supervised. The trainees will be entitled to appropriate subsistence allowance/ honorarium. The internship training is compulsory and a pre-requisite for obtaining registration from Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council.

The training consists of:

- √ 19 weeks training in Medicine & allied subjects.
- √ 19 weeks training in Surgery & allied subjects.
- √ 14 weeks training in Gynae & Obstetrics and Family Planning.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE STUDENTS

- 1. Students are advised to carry their identity card while inside the college and hospital.
- Students are advised to attend classes in clean and well dressed clothes with white aprons.
- Fashionable dress, cosmetics, untidy hair, slippers are discouraged in the college & hospital campus.
- 4. Rings and bangles are impediment in the practical classes.
- Smoking is forbidden in the college and hospital campus.
- Environment should be kept clean. Students are advised to throw litters into the waste bins.
- Pasting of posters and writing on the walls of the college and hospital premises are prohibited. Those are considered as act of indiscipline and offenders involved are liable to punishment.
- Closing of gates or doors the college, hospital and department and creating obstacles in the normal functioning are act of gross indiscipline and students involved in such acts are liable to be expelled from the college.
- All types of demonstrations, processions, shouting in the college and hospital premises are prohibited and students involved in these type of activities are liable to be expelled from the college.
- 10. Students must not misbehave with the staffs or employees of the college & hospital. Misbehavior is an act of indiscipline and liable to punishment.
- 11. Students are expected to maintain the highest standard in their academic and private lives. Loss of moral and spiritual values or addiction to alcohol and narcotic drugs are punishable.
- 12. At the time of admission into the college, students and parents/ guardians will have to sign a bond that students will abide by the rules and regulations of the college.
- 13. Every student shall have all the prescribed text books, dissecting instruments and medical equipments. The college will not supply these to the students.
- 14. In case of illness or other unavoidable reasons of absence, a written statement from the parent/ guardian should be presented to the concerned guide teacher & Head of the Department, who-in turn will submit it to the Principal for approval. In all cases leave taken will be at the student's own risk so far as percentage of attendance is concerned and even medical certificate will not condone any deficiency in attendance.



- 15. Cost of loss/ damage to college/ hospital property is liable to be realized from the student who is found responsible for the same activity.
- 16. Political activities are not permitted in the college.
- 17. To help and guide the students in academic matters like studies, examination, attendance, and conduct, batch students are placed under a teacher. Students are advised to meet their guide teacher whenever they require or asked by the teacher. Private tuition by faculty members is not allowed.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE

All students are required to abide by all the rules and regulations of the college. Non-adherence to these rules and regulations makes the students liable to disciplinary action which may range from warning to expulsion from the college. Students of AMC are forbidden to organize union, association or society other than those set up by the authority in order to enrich their physical, intellectual, social and ethical developments.

Penalty/ penalties imposed on a student will be recorded in his/ her Transcript/ Testimonial. A student's name may be removed from college register under the following circumstances:

- 1. Remaining absent from classes for more than 3 months without any information.
- 2. Disciplinary ground on the advice of the Academic Council.
- 3. Non-payment of college dues within 3 months of due date of payment.

RE-ADMISSION REGULATIONS OF DHAKA UNIVERSITY

The Re-admission for First Professional MBBS group will be acceptable with the fresh batch within three years.

- 1. Re-admission for re-examination in first professional MBBS Examination is acceptable within two & a half years plus six months for refresher course.
- 2. Re-admission for $2^{\rm nd}$, $3^{\rm rd}$ & Final Professional MBBS Examination will be acceptable within 05 (five) year.

If a student's name is removed from the college register due to non-payment of dues or punishment or cancellation of studentship, he/ she may be re-admitted provided he/ she pays full arear dues and a fine of Tk. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) within 3 months of removal of the name from register. If a student remains absent for more than three months but less than twelve months he/ she may be re-admitted on the recommendation of the Academic Council on full payment of arrear dues plus a fine of Tk. 12,500/- (Twelve thousand five hundred). However if a student remains absent for more than twelve months he/ she will not be admitted into the college except on special permission from the Academic Council of the college.

CONCLUSION

The College aims at improving the systems of medical education and health care delivery with the present day concept of medical education and training, which will have relevance to the need of the country. It is intended to bridge the gap between the need and resource for the development of health education, maternal and child welfare & other research to assist the government in its health sector.




1ST YEAR MBBS STUDENTS OATH
